OPEN ENROLLMENT FOR 2018-2019 APPLICATION PERIOD IS FEBRUARY 5TH – APRIL 30TH, 2018

Parents who wish to choose the public school district their children will attend next year have an important set of dates approaching: The February 5th – April 30th open enrollment application window. Under the Public School Open Enrollment Program, parents must apply during the application period to the school district they wish to have their children attend.

The DPI provides the following guidelines for parents who wish to apply for open enrollment:

Open enrollment deadlines are firm. The DPI requests that Open Enrollment forms be submitted on-line. You will find the website listed below. If you do not have access to a computer, please come to the school and we will help you fill out the form on-line.

Parents may submit applications to no more than three nonresident school districts. Early and late applications will not be accepted.

If your child attended a nonresident district under open enrollment for 2017-2018 you are NOT required to reapply for 2018-2019.

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FFA Half-Time Leadership Conference

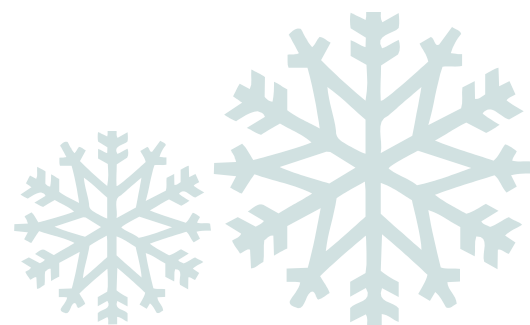
New Auburn FFA Chapter was well-represented at the Wisconsin Association of FFA Half-Time Leadership Conference held at the Holiday Inn & Convention Center in Stevens Point, Wisconsin, January 12-13, 2018. Over 350 FFA members, advisors and state FFA officers participated. The Half-Time Leadership Conference provides FFA chapter leaders from around the state the opportunity to set goals and prepare for the second half of their year of service in their local FFA chapters. FFA members attended workshops focused on leadership and personal development, membership and chapter development, and opportunities in FFA. They learned about preparing for FFA events and getting involved in community service. The Half-Time conference is a 32-year tradition for the Wisconsin Association of FFA to bring top FFA leaders from across the state together to learn more about what they can do in their local FFA chapters.

This year's leadership conference was designed and conducted by the 2017-2018 Wisconsin State FFA Officers. The theme of the conference was "Setting the Stage". *"Half-Time is one of the premier leadership conferences in our state and designed by student leaders. It allows FFA chapter leaders to develop their leadership skills, learn more about FFA activities and meet people while having fun,"* said Cheryl Zimmerman, State FFA Executive Director. *"We are able to provide young people with an excellent experience to develop their leadership skills and get them excited about Agriculture, Agricultural Education and the FFA so they can build their local programs."*

FFA advisors were also busy during the

weekend as they attended training sessions in the areas of youth livestock opportunities, re-energizing for the second half of the school year, FFA updates and other key topics in agricultural education. Teachers were also involved in the Wisconsin Association of Agricultural Educators (WAAE) Board Meetings and Committee meetings. New Auburn's Agriscience Instructor, Brenda J. Scheil, attended the Past Presidents State Committee Meeting. In addition, she provided a presentation titled *Agricultural Education ~ Maintaining Your Post*, with Jenifer Erb - Waupaca Agriscience Instructor. Their presentation provided instructors an opportunity to reflect on their style and program and identify those attributes that feed it while discovering new ideas. Inspirational points were presented showcasing a positive message to the Wisconsin Association of Agricultural Education members.

The Wisconsin Association of FFA comprised of 250 local chapters in high schools across the state prepares over 20,000 students for leadership and careers in the science, business and technology of agriculture. FFA activities and programs complement instruction in agriculture education by giving students practical experience in the application of agricultural skills and knowledge gained in classes. FFA's mission is to develop premier leadership, personal growth and career success through agricultural education.

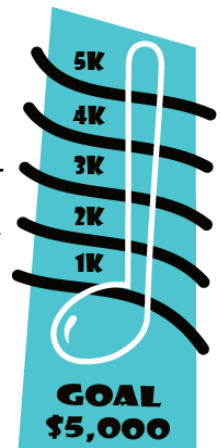

Dear Community Members,

We are pleased to announce that the New Auburn Music Department is preparing to travel to Chicago to perform at the Museum of Science and Industry this spring. In order to help offset costs, students began fundraising last year and we have several more opportunities ahead of us yet. However, we need **your** help to alleviate some of the costs for the students.

The combined cost of transportation and the performance at the Museum is \$5000. We would like to raise funds to cover this amount so that the students only need to raise \$300 towards accommodations, food, and Chicago experiences such as a musical, Medieval Times, Shedd Aquarium, and much more. We do however, have several students that will find it a challenge for their family to raise the funds needed, and we would love to see every student have the opportunity to go. So, every dollar over our \$5,000 goal will go to helping students in need.

We have several ways to offer great exposure for your business/organization, and we wanted to give an early opportunity for you to get involved. This year, we are reserving advertisement space in our Winter Concert program to recognize participating companies and organizations. This information will also be submitted to the Bloomer Advance and the Chetek Alert and will be put up on the school Facebook page. Contributions will be displayed in tiered amounts.
